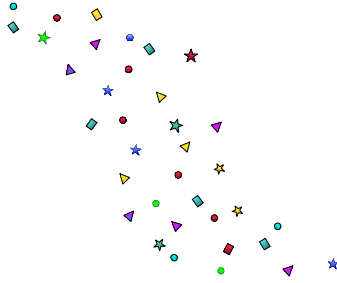
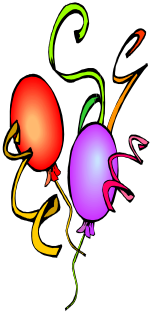


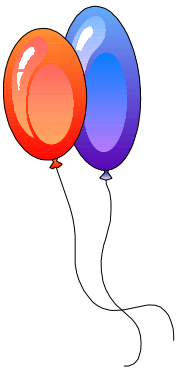

PRAYER CYCLE for the Churches of Hamilton Conference –

KNOX UNITED, AYR: The church was founded as a Presbyterian congregation in 1835. In 2009, their sanctuary was declared unsafe; alternate worship arrangements had to be made for several months while expensive repairs were conducted. Rev. Wayne Beamer is currently serving as interim minister following a long pastorate by Rev. Fred Hagle. Our prayers are needed as they search for a permanent pastor, as well as a new music director. ROCKWOOD-STONE: Rockwood-Stone United churches both continue as strong congregations with a healthy balance of ages and a close relationship with their respective communities. Rev. Lynne Bandy has been the minister for almost 20 years. Rockwood was born in 1867 as a Presbyterian church. 80-100 people worship each Sunday while the Sunday School has 40 children. A CE wing was added two years ago. The land for Stone Methodist church was acquired in 1846 with a building erected in 1862. Approximately 60 worship each Sunday.
